DESCRIPTION:

This product was developed to save money and shipping costs for our customers. Our regular product contains chelating agents, surfactants, emulsifiers, degreasers, foamers, wetting agents and a drying agent. It also contains 89% water. Our chemists have developed a way to take out all of the water and leave just the active ingredients. By eliminating the water from a 55 gallon drum of our regular product, you end up with 6 gallons of active ingredients. By adding (11%) of raw materials to 49 gallons (89%) of water you are actually making your own Car Wash Soap that can be diluted up to 400:1.

It is totally biodegradable, streak-resistant, safe on waxed surfaces and can be used with any type of car wash equipment.

DIRECTIONS:

First, Mix one bucket (6 gallons total) of Car Wash Soap Concentrate with 49 gallons of water to make one 55 gallon drum of a very concentrated Car Wash Soap. Stir with a broom handle or a small mixing blade.

Second, Mix according to the following dilutions.

Holding Tank Equipment: Mix 1 gallon of this product to 400 gallons of water.

Metered Injection Equipment: Should be adjusted to ½ to 1 ounce per automobile.

By Hand: Mix at a 1:200 ratio.

CAUTIONS:

Keep from freezing. If this product is stored in cold or freezing weather, it may separate or thicken. This will not harm the performance. Before using, warm to room temperature and stir thoroughly. Keep container sealed when not in use. Triple rinse and dispose of empty container in an authorized landfill site. If material comes in contact with skin or eyes, flush with clear water. If ingested, drink plenty of water and seek medical attention.
